

Dear Jamie,

Please see attached the previous submission of Saorgus Energy Ltd on TLAF's which we would like to resubmit along with the following observations.

1. We support abolition of the TLAF system as it is ineffective and does not function as intended. In reality it is a defunct system without a real purpose. If necessary, the money flows involved could be reallocated elsewhere, e.g. TUoS. This would mean that the final customer remains in the same position.

2. In addition to be ineffective, the TLAF actually has a very negative effect in creating a significant uncertainty in the investment case for any generation. However, as the bulk of new generation in the next several years will be renewable, it will have a disproportionate effect on projects needed for the achievement of EU 2020 RES-E targets.

3. Finally, as set out in the attached, it seems clearly arguable that the TLAF regime is contrary to the requirements of the EU Renewables Directive and that an EU Commission investigation of the system is possible. We feel that any such enquiry will find against the TLAF system because it discriminates against renewables.
