Market Codes

- Capacity Allocation and Congestion Management (CACM)
 - » EC has produced a merged CACM Network Code incorporating the Governance Guidelines into CACM. This new version was presented at the Florence Forum.
 - » Key Issues for SEM
 - Derogation to 2016
 - Designation of PXs
 - Flexibility for intraday auctions
 - » The SEM RAs priority at this stage is to remain involved at ACER level as the NC is finalised by the EC and to support the respective departments (DECC/DCENR) throughout the comitology process, which have started with a informal meeting on 31 May.
 - » Intraday Platform: PXs have failed to reach an agreement on the two vendors. ACER prepared an informal opinion to which the PXs will have 3 weeks to respond.

- Forwards
 - » Published for consultation by ENTSOE on 28th March
 - » Consultation closed on 28th May

- Balancing
 - » Expected to be published for consultation in mid summer 2013
 - » Early drafts and presentations on the ENTSOE website
 - » Central dispatch provisions are key for the redesign of the All Island Market.
 - NC must cater for central dispatch markets
 - » The SEM RAs is represented on the ACER team monitoring the development of this NC.

Technical Codes

- Operational Planning and Scheduling
 - » Submitted to ACER on 29th March 2013
 - » ACER has three months to provide an opinion

- Operational Security
 - » Submitted to ACER on 28th February 2013
 - » ACER has call for improvements to the network Code in its opinion of 28th May 2013. Main areas where improvement is suggested are;
 - Coherence and compatibility with other Network Codes
 - National scrutiny
 - Performance indicators

- Load Frequency Control and Reserves
 - » Published for consultation on 1st February 2013, which is now closed
 - » Code expected to be submitted to ACER in late June 2013

- High Voltage Direct Current (HVDC)
 - » Under development by ENTSOE
 - Letter sent by the EC on 29th April
 - » Expected to be published for consultation in summer 2013

- REMIT
 - » Consultation on technical requirements for data reporting under REMIT closed 7th May.
 - » ACER currently analysing consultation responses.
 - » A 3rd edition of ACER guidance on application of REMIT is expected to be published by end of summer. Key issues to be covered in this document include:
 - Insider trading prohibition, including examples of reporting obligations
 - Participant registration
 - » ACER intending to develop a market monitoring handbook Q3 2013
 - » RA contacts on REMIT are Andrew Ebrill in CER and Andrew McCorrison in UR.

- Capacity Mechanisms
 - » EC's Communication on State intervention in the internal energy market should be published in July.
 - » The EC will give guidance on how CRMs and RES support schemes should be designed based on the principles of necessity, proportionality and being transitional in nature.
 - » This is a key issue for SEM and the RAs will remain involved in discussions at EU level.

- Infrastructure Regulation and Projects of Common Interest
 - » EC will submit a draft regional PCI lists to ACER: 14th June
 - » ACER will provide an opinion in mid-July
 - » On September 2013 the Union wide PCI list will be adopted by Commission through delegated act.
 - » The EC will simultaneously publish a Communication on long term infrastructure vision and a technical working paper
